BEST MAGAZINE ARTICLE — FIRST QUARTER 1954

Once again it is the pleasure of the Foundation advisory committee to commend Benjamin P. Thomas for having contributed the best magazine article on Abraham having contributed the best magazine article on Abraham Lincoln appearing during the first quarter of the year. The monograph which brought him recognition was entitled, "Abe Lincoln, Country Lawyer," which appeared in The Atlantic for February. Last year Mr. Thomas was given similar recognition among 1953 discussions for his article entitled "Profile of a President" appearing in Look.

The very interesting series of outlines and charts which Richard Friend Lufkin has been contributing to the Lincoln Herald was recognized by the Foundation advisory group as the second choice. It is the fourth in a series by Mr. Lufkin of The Lincoln Group of Boston entitled "Mr. Lincoln's Light From Under a Bushel" The item appeared in the Winter edition of the Herald.

There seemed to be an especially large number of Lincoln articles in the magazines for the first quarter of 1954. Those eligible for attention in competition and also those with mechanical requisites failing to measure up to the rules laid down for consideration are presented.
