For 1955 a contribution appearing in American Heritage for February entitled "Riding the Circuit with Lincoln" by William King has been selected for first honors. The monograph by Harry Pratt entitled "Lincoln and the Division of Sangaron County" was highly companded gamon County" was highly commended.

The magazine is one type of literature which presents excellent source material of the life and times of Abraham Lincoln. The foundation library contains more than 3,500 magazine contributions separately bound and filed according to the subject treated. Not only a subject approach is available but also title and author indexes allow the student to refer quickly to nearly any discussion appearing in periodicals since Lincoln's administration.
