

ne of the goals of Lincoln Lore is to bring something of The Lincoln Museum to our many readers who live too far from Fort Wayne to visit the Museum as often as they might like. Recent articles on the Lincoln Highway, the gowns of the First Ladies, and historians' ratings of the Presidents have reflected then-current temporary exhibits at the Museum. Stories and cover illustrations have displayed some of the Museum's more dramatic new acquisitions, including the inkwell used by Lincoln to sign the Final Emancipation Proclamation on January 1, 1863, and a printed copy of the document itself, signed by Lincoln, William Seward and John Nicolay.

In this issue, we present another aspect of the Lincoln Museum experience, a visit to the Museum Store, in the form of a catalog showing some of the items available for purchase, either in person or by mail. From the first stages of the design of the Museum's permanent exhibit, "Abraham Lincoln and the American Experiment," the Museum Store was viewed as an integral part of the plan. The Store serves as an educational extension of the exhibit, offering visitors the chance to remember and expand upon their day at the Museum with books, artifact and document reproductions, toys and games, clothing, jewelry, keepsakes, and other items.

Since opening our present facility in 1995, we have received many requests for a mail order catalog of Museum Store items. Whether it be a hard-to-find Lincoln title that you've been seeking, or a refrigerator magnet that through long familiarity will teach your two-year-old to recognize the face of "Mr. Lincoln" (it happened in our house), I trust that you will find something of value here in the Museum Store - GJP.














