BIBLIOGRAPHY

The small amount of Lincoln literature appearing during the summer months makes the quarterly bibliography list for this period quite brief.

This extra space gives us an opportunity to introduce one or two new features which we hope to continue in these lists of current Lincolniana.

There are several book dealers in America who make a specialty of Lincoln literature and at certain intervals during the year issue priced catalogs of items they have for sale. It is our purpose to publish a list of book catalogues we receive which have any considerable number of Lincoln items for sale.

The dealers in used books have been a big factor in building up the libraries of our Lincoln collectors and they are usually glad to forward catalogues to any one who may request them.

A note on one of these catalogues during the summer stated that the dealer's sales of Lincoln items during the month were 100% greater than the corresponding month in 1929.

It also seems advisable to publish a list of Lincoln current events in order that those who may desire to secure first hand information and literature about these various activities may do so.

We trust that we may have the cooperation of all Lincoln collectors in gathering information about Lincoln books and periodicals, which appear from time to time.
