100 SCARCE LINCOLN BOOKS

More than three thousand books about Abraham Lincoln have been published. Most of these titles are out of print, many of them are difficult to obtain and at least one hundred are seldom listed in rare book catalogues.

On June 23, 1908 the Lincoln collectors known as the "Big Five," including Fish, Lambert, McLellan, Oakleaf and Stewart all now deceased, published a combined list of Lincoln titles which one, or more of them lacked.

In this combined want list there were thirty-seven titles which no one of the five collectors had been able to secure and about one hundred others which but one of the group possessed. Individual want lists were published later which allowed the editor of Lincoln Lore to compile what seems to be one hundred of the rarest volumes in the Lincoln bibliography by Fish.

Although some of these books are in its library, the Lincoln Historical Research Foundation would be pleased to learn of any of the following items that are available:
