SPEECHES AND PROGRAMS FOR LINCOLN'S BIRTHDAY

The Lincoln Historical Research Foundation has an increasing number of requests each year for material which can be used for speeches and programs on Lincoln's birthday.

The back numbers of Lincoln Lore offer a very rich supply of subject matter which is available for those who care to use it. The following outlines have been prepared with subjects which may serve as topics for discussions by several individuals, or one person may find it more convenient to use the material as a source for an address.

It takes about seven minutes to read one issue of the bulletin so that if several people are to participate in the program the time schedule can be figured quite accurately.

An effort has been made to choose subjects which might appeal to different groups and if the particular needs of any group are not covered, other bulletins contain material which may be worked into shape for the peculiar demands of the organization in mind. The index in the last number of the year will be helpful in finding the information wanted.
