An urgent need for a master list of the letters written by Abraham Lincoln was supplied by "Lincoln Lore" in 1930 and 1931. The compilation arranged at that time cited all letters written by Lincoln which had been published in the standard works on this subject, namely: Nicolay and Hay, Tarbell, Gettysburg Edition, Federal Edition, Angel, Tracey, and Brown University Collection.

The new compilation of Lincoln's writings brought together by Emanuel Hertz, now available in Volume II of his "Abraham Lincoln, A New Portrait," published by Horace Liveright, Inc., New York, makes it timely to present this supplement copy of the Lincoln Letter Series.

The following compilation consists of those letters appearing in the Hertz volume but not found in the other standard works already mentioned. They are designated by the symbol (H). There are also included letters noted by the Lincoln Historical Research Foundation not appearing in the Hertz volume or the other standard works. These are designated by an asterisk.

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
