## LIVING SCULPTORS OF ABRAHAM LINCOLN

The task of preserving in the most enduring form the likeness of Abraham Lincoln has been left to the sculptor. The descriptive data of the written page and the portrait on the inspired canvass may suffice for the hour, but with the piling of century upon century the works of art most likely to endure are the heroic bronze statues of "The Man for the Ages."

It is a worthy ambition for a sculptor to hope that at some time in his career he may be commissioned to do a Lincoln, and one appreciative study usually calls for another. It is with this thought in mind that a directory of living sculptors, who have done outstanding heroic bronze statues of Lincoln, has been prepared.

There is no attempt to compile a list of other noteworthy productions conceived by these famous sculptors, but the works are confined to studies of Abraham Lincoln.

### BARNARD, GEORGE GREY

Born in Bellefonte, Pa., May 24, 1863. Created "Lincoln the Candidate," which was unveiled March 31, 1917, at Cincinnati, Ohio. Replicas of this statue are in Louisville, Ky., and Manchester, England. Now lives in New York City.

### BORGLUM, GUTZON

Born in Idaho, March 25, 1871. Created "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled May 30, 1911, at Newark, N. J. Now lives in Stamford, Conn.

### CRUNELLE, LEONARD

Born in Lens, Pas-de-Calais, France, July 8, 1872. Created "Lincoln the Debater," which was unveiled August 27, 1929, at Freeport, Ill.; and "Lincoln the Captain," which was unveiled August 23, 1930, at Dixon, Ill. Now lives in Chicago.

### FRASER, JAMES EARLE

Born in Winona, Minn., November 4, 1876. Created "Lincoln the Statesman," which was unveiled in

1931, at Jersey City, N. J. Now lives in New York City.

### GAGE, ROBERT MERRILL

Born in Topeka, Kansas, December 26, 1892. Created "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled February 12, 1918, at Topeka, Kans. Now lives in Santa Ana, Calif.

### GANIERE, GEORGE E.

Born in Chicago, Ill. Created "Lincoln of the Second Inaugural," which was unveiled in 1913, at Webster City, Iowa; and "Lincoln the President," which was also unveiled in 1913, at Burlington, Wis. Now lives at DeLand, Florida.

### HERING, HENRY

Born in New York City, February 15, 1874. Created "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled April 10, 1935, at Indianapolis, Ind. Now lives in New York City.

### KALISH, MAX

Born in Poland, March 1, 1891. Created "Lincoln at Gettysburg," which was unveiled in 1931, at Cleveland, Ohio. Now lives in New York City.

### KECK, CHARLES

Born in New York City, September 9, 1875. Created "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled May 30, 1932, at Wabash, Ind. Now lives in New York City.

### KONTI, ISIDORE

Born in Vienna, Austria, July 9, 1862. Created "Lincoln of the Second Inaugural," which was unveiled October 12, 1929, at Yonkers, N. Y. Now lives at Yonkers.

### LEWIS, ALONZO VICTOR

Created "Lincoln, the President" which was unveiled November 11, 1930, at Spokane, Wash. Now lives at Seattle, Wash.

### MANSHIP, PAUL

Born in St. Paul, Minn., December 25, 1885. Created "Lincoln the

Hoosier Youth," which was unveiled September 16, 1932, at Fort Wayne, Ind. Now lives in New York City.

### O'CONNOR, ANDREW

Born Worcester, Mass., June 7, 1874. Created "The President-Elect," which was unveiled October 5, 1918, at Springfield, Ill. Now lives in Paris, France.

### PATIGIAN, HAIG

Born in City of Van, Armenia, January 22, 1876. Created "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled February 13, 1928, at San Francisco, Calif. Now lives in San Francisco.

### REBECK, STEPHEN A.

Born in Cleveland, Ohio, in 1891. Created "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled July 4, 1924, at Alliance, Ohio. Now lives in Cleveland Heights, Ohio.

### SCHWEIZER, J. OTTO

Born in Zurich, Switzerland, March 27, 1865. Created "Lincoln at Gettysburg," which was unveiled in 1917, at Gettysburg, Pa.; and "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled November 24, 1917, at Philadelphia, Pa. Now lives at Philadelphia.

### TAFT, LORADO

Born in Elmwood, Ill., April 29, 1860. Created "The Circuit Rider," which was unveiled in 1927, at Urbana, Ill. Now lives in Chicago.

### WATERS, GEORGE F.

Born in San Francisco, Calif., October 6, 1894. Created "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled in 1928, at Portland, Oregon. Now lives in France.

### WEINMAN, ADOLPH ALEXANDER

Born Karlsruhe, Baden, Germany, December 11, 1870. Created "Lincoln the President," which was unveiled May 31, 1909, at Hodgenville, Ky. Now lives at Forest Hills, N. Y.
