PROPOSALS FOR CONGRESSIONAL LINCOLN MEMORIALS

One of the first attempts to compile information about various pro-posals on the part of Congress to memoralize Abraham Lincoln, is found in the Congressional Record for Janu-ary 29, 1913. The recorded speech was by Hon. William W. Griest in the House of Representatives on a resolu-House of Representatives on a resolu-tion to approve "the plan, design and location for a Lincoln Memorial". Congressman Griest prepared a list of all the Lincoln Memorial projects au-thorized by Congress up to 1913 and summarized them as follows:

A joint congressional memorial service.

- The purchase of a statue of Lincoln for the Capitol.
- The purchase of a portrait of Lincoln for the Executive Mansion.

The establishment of Lincoln Square, or Park, in the city of Washington.

The incorporation of the Lincoln Monument Association, of the District of Columbia, to which condemned bronze cannon was donated.

The donation of damaged and cap-tured ordnance to the National Lin-coln Monument Association, at Spring-field, Ill., and also the stone presented by the patriots of Rome to the late President Lincoln President Lincoln.

The creation of a commission to secure plans and designs for a monument or memorial of Lincoln.

The erection of a tablet with the dedication address of Lincoln, at Gettysburg, Pa.

An appropriation was included in the War Department appropriation bill for the purchase of the house in which Lincoln died. The following year an appropriation of \$3,833.50 was made for repairing the house in which Lincoln died. (Vols. 29 and 30, Stat. L.)

The act declaring the 12th Febru-ary, 1909, to be a legal holiday.

The issuance of a special Lincoln postage stamp for the hundredth an-niversary of Lincoln's birthday.

Creation of a commission to secure plans and designs for a monument of memorial.

Possibly of more value than the above summary is a listing of all bills which presented in any way, refer-ences to a Lincoln Memorial project. The numerals in the compilation which The numerals in the compliation which follows refer to the House of Represen-tatives Bill number; an asterisk fol-lowing the number indicates a Senate Bill number; the capital "L" in each instance stands for Lincoln and each subject is followed by the name of the Compressmen introducing the bill.
