BEST MAGAZINE ARTICLE, FIRST QUARTER, 1945

One of the most noticeable contributions to the growing interest in Lincolniana is an increasing number of worthwhile magazine articles featuring some phase of the Lincoln story. Each year the contest for the best monograph bearing on Lincolniana, appearing in the issues of January, February, or March becomes more and more keenly contested. It has been necessary for the judges to select first, second, and third choices to finally arrive at a just decision.

The contributions this year seem to have been far above the average and anyone of the first half-dozen receiving approval of the judges would have been worthy of recognition. This fact makes the coveted honor this year of more than usual significance. Jay Monaghan's monograph entitled, "An Analysis of Lincoln Funeral Sermons," appearing in the *Indiana Magazine of History*, for May 1945, was awarded first place by the judges.

The several years of hard and painstaking work which Mr. Monaghan has been putting into the Lincoln effort is bearing rich fruitage. His two volume *Lincoln Bibliography*, the more recent *A Diplomat in Carpet Slippers*, just from the press, and the prize-winning magazine article allows him to enter the field of Lincoln contributors with something of an ovation welcoming him.
