While the title was a misnomer the publication was a very commendable work, the author having compiled a large number of the more important speeches writings and state papers of Lincoln important speeches, writings and state papers of Lincoln and with brief introductory paragraphs wove them together in chronological sequence.

Same as above in every respect except cover in sheep skin. Not so elaborately embossed and backstrip on black lable as follows "Life of Abraham Lincoln," "With His Official Documents." End sheets yellow.

Contents same as above except no line box for each page, and size of pages 7% x 4% cover black cloth embossed with gilt lettering on backstrip. Lavender end sheets.

Large Paper 1866 Edition Contents same as No. 1, but bears date 1866 on title page and on copyright page a different imprint namely: "Philadelphia/Stereotyped by S. A. George/Collins, Printer." Cover red cloth embossed with different printing on back strip and full name of publisher "John E. Potter & Co."

Thick Copy Edition

From same plates as No. 2 but Lincoln quotation page designated (1) now movel to recto page just before preface. New imprint on title page "Philadelphia/John E. Potter and Company/617 Sanson St." Wine colored cover decorations in black except title and author on backstrip in gilt. 7% x 4%. Change in advertisements. Brown end sheets.

Thin Copy Edition

Contents identical with No. 4 except slightly changed in advertisements but printed on thin paper. Black cover with "book shelf" design and a new type line on backstrip. Brown endsheets.

Plato Edition

Same as No. 2 except change in advertisements and imprint same as No. 5. A new backstrip with picture of Plato. Brown cover, brown endsheets.

8. Presentation Copy Edition (1885)
Same contents as No. 2 except page 1 of Lincoln quotations left out and no advertisements. An extra page in colors bound in just before frontispiece entitled: "Presented to—by—copyright 1885 by Thomes Hunter." Front cover design bears name "Abraham Lincoln" but backstrip same as No. 7.

Harrison Edition (1885)

Identical in every respect with No. 8 except changed imprint. "Chicago, Ill.:/W. H. Harrison, Jr./Publisher and Bookseller,/315 Wabash Ave.

Multiple Street Number Edition

Identical in every way with No. 9 except blue cover, absence of presentation page and the new imprint on title page "Philadelphia:/John E. Potter & Company/No. 29,31,33, and 35 North 10th St."

11. Keystone 1890 Edition

Same as above except brown cover and change in im-print on title page "Philadelphia:/The Keystone Publishing Co./1890.

12. Keystone n. d. Edition

Same as above in every respect except imprint "Philadelphia, Pa.:/The Keystone Publishing Co./N.E. Cor. Truth and Filbert Sts."

International Edition

Same plates as above except title page imprint "New York/International Book Company/310-318 Sixth Avenue." Also new frontispiece and new cover design with figure of a youth on both front cover and backstrip. On front cover "St. Nicholas Series." Bound in red cloth 7 x 4%.

 Collier 1900 Edition
 Same plates as above except reset title page in two
 colors "A Library of/Universal Literature/in four parts/ comprising science, biography, fiction/and other great orations/Part two-Biography/Life of Abraham Lincoln/ Sixteenth President of the/United States/by/Frank Crosby/member of the Philadelphia Bar/Device/New York/P.
