## BEST MAGAZINE ARTICLE, FIRST QUARTER, 1947

There seemed to be an unusually large number of magazine articles published during the first three months of 1947 which is a much more dependable indication of the current interest in the Lincoln story than the number of pamphlets coming from the press, A person with sufficient funds to publish a monograph may bring one out privately printed but there must be some merit at least in a story accepted by a magazine.

One will not be surprised to learn that Professor James G. Randall of the University of Illinois who has contributed so many worth while writings to our growing Lincolniana has been awarded the honor of preparing the best Lincoln magazine article for the first quarter of 1947. Nor will one be surprised to recognize the thesis of his discussion, as the most talked of subject in the field of Lincolniana during the past few months namely; the opening of the Lincoln papers in the Library of Congress. Dr. Randall's article entitled "Great Unanswered Questions About Lincoln" appeared in the New York Times Magazine for February 2, 1947.

The runner up in this annual balloting by the Advisory Group of the Lincoln Foundation is Professor Roy P. Basler of the University of Florida whose article "The Birth of a Reputation" published in the Abraham Lincoln Quarterly for March, 1947, was highly commended.
