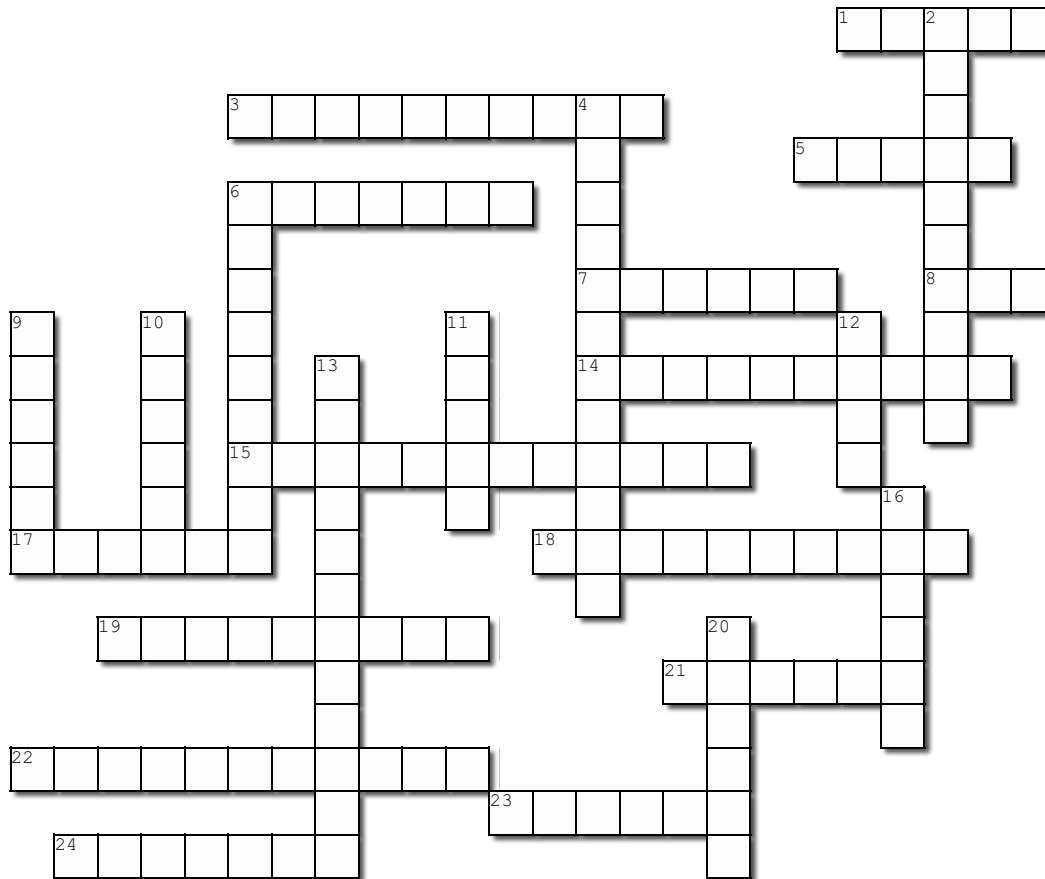


Lincoln Collection Crossword
